

## VEGETABLE PRODUCTION

In the year of 2008, according to statistical data, the share of vegetables in total sown fields was 15%, i.e. 81.000 ha. The total vegetable production was 706.030 t.

As far as production structure is concerned, potato is a predominant vegetable, which is sown on 40.243 ha with an average yield of 424.900 t. Other single vegetables were sown on 40.800 ha with an average production of 281.400 t.

According to Vegetable Growth Index, in 2008, a positive growth trend of almost all vegetable crops is noted, inter alia, potato by 9,7%, cabbage and kale by 4,3%, tomato by 22,1%, onion by 10,3% and carrot by 20,9%.
